

Italy Trip 2010 *Application Process*

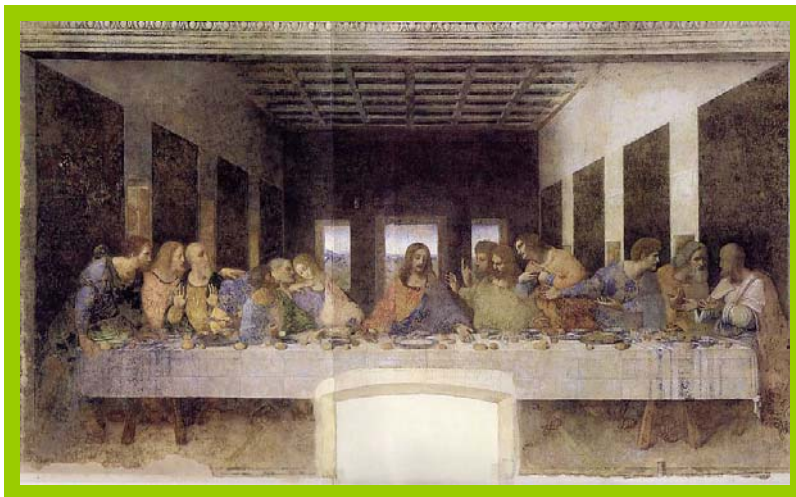
- 🏛️ Students applying for a trip may not have any incomplete grades, nor be in arrears with the St. Mary's business office, nor be behind in their community service hours. We will check with Mrs. Anderson in the Registrar's Office, Ms. Roth in the Business Office, and Mr. Wing in the Community Service Office.
- 🏛️ All trip participants (and students' parents) must sign the attached **Hold Harmless Agreement** and **Student Travel Contract**

Selection Process: If more people apply to participate in the 2010 Italy Trip than places are available, the following criteria will be used to prioritize them.

1. Students must be of good character that the school will be proud to have representing it abroad.
2. Enrollment in Latin.
3. Enrollment in Art History.
4. No previous participation in any St. Mary's foreign travel.
5. Clearly written essay stating the student's reason for participation in this trip.
6. Students must complete the application process, including being up to date with his or her community service hours and his or her account with the business office is current.
7. Students and their parents must sign the attached foreign travel contract, *the conditions of which should be read most carefully by both students and their parents/guardians*

Field trips are privileges afforded to students, not absolute rights. The school reserves the right to deny participation to students who fail to meet the academic or behavioral requirements.

Hold Harmless Agreement Foreign Travel

Read carefully before signing this form.

The St. Mary's School foreign travel tour traveling to Italy during the period March 18 -31, 2010, (the Tour) is a voluntary, extracurricular activity. As a condition to participation in the Tour, the student, parent(s) or guardian(s), (the "Participant") must agree to ASSUME THE RISKS OF INJURY, LOSS OF PROPERTY, DETAINMENT, KIDNAPPING, IMPRISONMENT OR DEATH involved in this activity and agree to RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND *St. Mary's of Medford, Inc., dba St. Mary's School*, its employees, agents and representatives and the trip coordinators, directors and hosts ("St. Mary's") from any and all liability (including defense costs) resulting from injury and/or death sustained by the Participant of the Tour, or damage to property of any kind, or from any loss whatsoever occurring or arising out of the Tour, except that the hold harmless and indemnification shall *not be applicable to liability arising from the negligence or the willful misconduct of St. Mary's of Medford, Inc., dba St. Mary's School.*

Warning

While involved in the Tour and while traveling to and within foreign countries, the Participant may encounter unusual diseases, climate and atmospheric conditions, food and water conditions and limited sanitation. Modes of conveyance, public and private, may be below the standard used in the United States. Political unrest can result in violence and terrorist incidents. You may want to research these further before deciding whether to sign this form. Consult any sources, e.g. U.S. Passport Office, U.S. Immigration Office, U.S. State Department, World Health Organization, consulates, travel agents, universities, books and periodicals.

The Participant may impair his/her general physical and mental health and hinder his/her ability to earn a living, to engage in business, social and recreational activities, and generally to enjoy life. In addition, there is the possibility of suffering emotional distress or psychological injury as a result of participating in the trip and its activities. It is difficult to project what Participants will undergo or what situations they will encounter.

It is your responsibility to learn about and/or inquire about any concerns that you might have at any time regarding the Tour, before signing the agreement.

In consideration of St. Mary's of Medford, Inc., dba St. Mary's School, permitting my child or ward, or myself to participate in the Tour and to engage in all activities related to it, I hereby agree to ASSUME ALL OF THE RISKS OF INJURY, LOSS OF PROPERTY, DETAINMENT, KIDNAPPING, IMPRISONMENT OR DEATH of me, my child, or ward that are associated with St. Mary's of Medford, Inc., dba St. Mary's School, its employees, agents, representatives and volunteers from any liability resulting from any condition that may arising out of the Tour, except negligence or willful misconduct of St. Mary's of Medford, Inc., dba St. Mary's School. I agree that the terms that of this Agreement shall bind myself, my heirs, estate, personal representatives, assigns and all members of my family. Furthermore, I agree if any part of this Agreement is held void or unenforceable, that it shall not affect the remainder of this Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect.
